Part 1: Everyday Phrasal Verbs

- **Wake up** – stop sleeping
- **Get up** – rise from bed
- **Sit down** – take a seat
- **Stand up** – rise to your feet
- **Turn on** – start a machine/light
- **Turn off** – stop a machine/light
- **Put on** – wear clothes
- **Take off** – remove clothes / when a plane leaves the ground
- **Pick up** – lift something / collect someone
- **Drop off** – take someone/something to a place
- **Look after** – take care of
- **Look for** – try to find
- **Look at** – direct your eyes
- **Look up** – search for information
- **Go out** – leave home for fun
- **Come in** – enter a place
- **Come back** – return
- **Run out (of)** – have no more left
- **Give back** – return something
- **Throw away** – put in the trash
- **Turn around** – change direction
- **Go back** – return to a place
- **Bring in** – introduce something new
- **Put away** – store something in its place
- **Turn up** – arrive / increase volume
- **Turn down** – refuse / decrease volume
- **Get back** – return
- **Hold up** – delay
- **Break off** – end suddenly
- **Check out** – look at / leave a hotel

Part 2: Work, Study & Travel Phrasal Verbs

- **Fill in** – complete a form
- **Hand in** – give work to a teacher/boss
- **Write down** – make a note
- **Cross out** – draw a line through
- **Find out** – discover
- **Figure out** – solve/understand
- **Carry out** – perform/complete
- **Go over** – review/check
- **Point out** – show/indicate
- **Set up** – arrange/start something
- **Call off** – cancel
- **Put off** – delay/postpone
- **Take on** – accept responsibility
- **Take over** – gain control
- **Check in** – register at a hotel/airport
- **Check out** – leave a hotel / look at
- **Get on** – enter bus/train/plane
- **Get off** – leave bus/train/plane
- **Break down** – stop working (machines)
- **Hurry up** – move faster
- **Go ahead** – start / proceed
- **Cut out** – remove / stop doing something
- **Keep on** – continue doing something
- **Carry on** – continue
- **Log in** – enter a computer system
- **Log out** – exit a computer system
- **Back up** – make a copy of data
- **Hand out** – distribute
- **Look over** – quickly examine
- **Work on** – spend time improving

Part 3: Advanced & Useful Phrasal Verbs

- **Break up** – end a relationship
- **Make up** – invent / become friends again
- **Bring up** – mention a topic
- **End up** – finally do/arrive somewhere
- **Grow up** – become an adult

- **Catch up (with)** – reach the same level
- **Keep up (with)** – stay at the same level
- **Hold on** – wait
- **Hang out** – spend time together
- **Hang up** – end a phone call
- **Back up** – support / make a copy
- **Show up** – arrive/appear
- **Break into** – enter by force
- **Work out** – exercise / find a solution
- **Cut down (on)** – reduce
- **Cut off** – stop supply/connection
- **Deal with** – manage a problem
- **Take care of** – look after
- **Give up** – stop trying
- **Set off** – start a journey
- **Look down on** – think you are better than someone
- **Look up to** – admire someone
- **Break through** – make a sudden advance
- **Get away with** – escape punishment
- **Look forward to** – be excited about the future
- **Put up with** – tolerate
- **Sort out** – organize/solve a problem
- **Carry on with** – continue doing something
- **Go through with** – complete something difficult
- **Bring about** – cause something to happen
